<p>According to Ohio law, type A and type B home child care providers must either maintain liability insurance in the specified amount <b>OR</b> obtain a statement from the parents of children in care that verifies the parent's understanding that the home does not carry liability insurance.</p>	
<p>By signing this form I have been made aware that this family day-care home does not carry liability Insurance which meets the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is provided by an insurer authorized to do business in Ohio under Chapter 3905. of the Revised Code.</li> <li>• Insures the type A or type B child care home against liability arising out of or in connection with, the operation of the child care home.</li> <li>• The insurance shall provide coverage in the amount of at least one hundred thousand dollars per occurrence and three hundred thousand dollars in the aggregate.</li> </ul> <p>I am aware that if the licensee of the type A family child care home or the provider of the type B family child care home is not the owner of the real property where the family child care home is located, the liability insurance, if any, of the owner of the real property may not provide for coverage of any liability arising out of, or in connection with, the operation of the home.</p>
