He has presented about child maltreatment, children's mental health, neurodevelopment and youth violence in a variety of venues including policy-making bodies such as the White House Summit on Violence, the California Assembly and House Committee on Education and to many media outlets including National Public Radio, The Today Show, Good Morning America, and the Oprah Winfrey Show.
