

Title XX Funding Plan

Every biennium, Franklin County is responsible for the completion of the annual Title XX County Profile to comply with the statutory requirements of ODJFS, which administers the funds. ODJFS collaborates with the state’s Departments of Mental Health and Addiction Services and the Department of Developmental Disabilities to distribute funds to the 88 CDJFS. In turn, local agencies utilize Title XX funds to support services provided directly to adults, children, and/or their families.

Each county is responsible for the completion of an annual Title XX County Profile, which indicates how they intend to spend their Title XX allocation during the federal fiscal year. There is a multi-step process required to submit a Profile. Each county must host a public hearing to present its initial Title XX County Profile and receive comments and feedback. The agency can make changes to the Profile following the public hearing. The CDJFS Director and President of the Board of Commissioners must sign a copy of the Title XX Profile. The signed copy will remain on file at the CDJFS to present at a state hearing upon request or in the event of an inquiry.

The table below provides an overview of services included in Franklin County’s Title XX County Profile for federal fiscal years (FFY) 2022 and 2023 as well as 2024 and 2025. No changes were made to the categories of possible services under the Profile for FFY 24 and FFY25. The total funding amount listed on the Profile is \$4,130,000.00 which provides the potential to serve over 23,700 Franklin County residents.
