Permission for Water Play & Swimming Activities

5101:2-14-23 (B) (E) (F) - The provider may use wading pools less than eighteen inches in wall height regardless of the amount of water put into it. The type B home provider shall obtain written permission from the caretaker:

- 1) Before the child is permitted to swim in water more than eighteen inches.
- 2) Before infants and toddlers use wading pools.

The written permission shall be valid for twelve months or until withdrawn by caretaker. The written permission shall be signed and dated by the caretaker, be on file for twelve months, and include all of the following:
