The **Right to Recover** program, from the City of Columbus, offers Columbus residents financial assistance to take time off work, isolate, and recover from COVID-19. This resource is vital to lessening the risk of spreading COVID-19.

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a Resident of Columbus
- Tested positive with COVID-19 within the last 14 days and are committing to quarantine at home for 14 days after the diagnosis;
- Are employed 20 hours a week or more; and
- Earn under 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (see chart below for info)
